

Move Mental Checklist

Do I have any checking moves?

If Yes, do they accomplish anything?

Can I be checked?

Are any of my pieces hanging or underdefended?

Does my opponent have any weaknesses I can exploit?

Are there any tactics open to me?

e.g., Discovered attacks, Forks, Pins, Skewers

Can I move any pieces to a more active position?

Can I occupy or control any outpost¹ squares or open files?

Can I blockade an enemy's knight or bishop with a pawn push?

¹ An outpost is a square on the fourth, fifth, sixth, or seventh rank which is protected by a pawn and which cannot be attacked by an opponent's pawn.

3. Bb5

Morphy Defence

3. ... a6

(Exchange Variation) No material advantage:

4. Bxc6 dxc6

5. Nxe5 Qd4 Qd4 forks the knight and pawn.

(Open Defence)

5. 0-0 Nxe4
